


Inclusive Teaching



: Inclusive teaching strategies refer to pedagogical practices that address the needs of **all** students from all backgrounds (including those who are differently abled), across all learning modalities, so that all students have equal opportunities to experience a successful learning. These strategies contribute to an overall inclusive learning environment in which students feel equally valued. Inclusive strategies are employed when designing course content, during assessment, and in a number of other pedagogical practices.
